July meeting minutes were approved.

Current business:

Fall Workshop: How you teach is what you teach

- Brandy and Julie are working on program w/ Susan
- Very practical workshop taking concepts and skill and at least two people presenting on the same skills and then discussion
- How many different concepts can we do in one day running from 9:30 – 3:30?
 - Could get 4 concepts: 9:45 – 10:45 (session 1) 11 -12 (lunch) 1:15 – 2:15 (session 2), 2:30 – 3:15 (session 3), 3:15 – 3:30 (session 4)
 - Allow 30 minutes for discussion
 - Group agreed that 4 concepts are enough
 - Some examples might be:
 - Process of developing research questions
 - Setting up search statements
 - Ethical use of information using searching and citing images as an example
 - Evaluating sources
 - When is Google appropriate?
 - Consider how you teach by using tutorials or learning objects
- Want to do clicker evaluation at end of session
- Possible lunch table topics: Why discovery tools? Should we be teaching freshmen on line?
- Need to send out a Call for Participants to show us how you teach
 - Give a 10 – 15 minute teaching demo using strategies/practices that you currently use in the classroom to teach a skill.
 - Participant announcement should provide registration information (Lisa Sweeney) and who will receive proposals (Susan Cooperstein)
- Will plan to post handouts on the MILEX Wiki
- Registration fees:

 - Registration fee will be waived for presenters
